

PROCEDURES OF REGISTRATION FOR NATIONAL IDENTITY CARDS IN THE DIASPORA

1. Introduction



The Registration of Persons Act (ROPA) mandates National Identification Registration Authority to register and issue national Identifications to Ugandans living in the Diaspora.

Section 59 of the ROPA provides for official premises of Uganda mission to serve as registration and issuance centers

2. Registration Requirements:

- a) Applicants must appear in person
- b) Form 3 fully filled

3. Attachments required are listed below:

- a. Where both parents of the applicant are alive;
 - Copy of the national Id of parents
 - Copy of applicant's passport Mandatory
 - b. If both parents of the applicant do not have national IDs, the applicant needs to produce the following;
 - Copy of a valid passport
 - Birth certificate
 - LC1 letter from the place of origin of the applicant and must be signed by the District Internal Security Officer (DISO).
 - c. Where the applicant has no clear links to Uganda;
 - Recommendation letter from the embassy
 - Birth certificate Mandatory
4. **Dual Citizens, citizens by registration and Naturalization**, need certified copies of their certificates and a copy of Ugandan passport
5. **Ugandans citizenship acquired by 1995 constitution** include the following requirements:
 - Evidence of proof of citizenship
